2017 Fire Prevention Poster Contest

1. The contest theme is *"Every Second Counts: Plan 2 Ways Out!"* Today's home fires present increased risks to occupants with newer homes being built with lightweight materials that burn faster than older home construction. They also tend to be designed with open floor plans that enable fire to spread rapidly. These factors highlight the importance of designing a home escape plan and having practice drills regularly.

2. Posters should promote fire prevention and encourage fire safety awareness in the home, school, and community.
3. Each student that wishes to participate will submit one poster. Poster board will be provided to each student participant. Any art medium can be utilized, including paint, cut-outs, pen and ink, crayons, chalks, pencils, computer graphics, etc.
4. Every K-5 participant turning in a poster by September 28th (early submission) will be eligible for a \$20 Sonic Gift Card (one per grade level). Each participant will need to write their name, their teacher's name, and classroom number on the back of their poster.
5. A \$100 gift card will be awarded to the teacher who has the most students participate.
6. A panel of judges will select the top three posters from each grade-level, along with a grand prize winner, second and third place. Selection based on the posters originality, clarity of message, and design.
7. The grand prize poster will be featured in the November edition of the City of Shavano Park's "Roadrunner Newsletter" along with the entire class receiving an in-class ice-cream party delivered by the Shavano Park Fire Department.
8. All posters will be up for display and the winners will be announced at City Hall during National Night Out which begins at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, October 3rd, 2017. The grand prize poster will remain on display at the Shavano Park Fire Department for the remaining of the 2017-2018 school year, representing the commitment to fire safety.
9. Posters will be returned to Blattman Elementary so that they may be displayed throughout the month of October. Each poster represents a very important message regarding fire safety and each student should take pride in knowing that they are helping to share that message to others.
